There was discussion on who should attend State Equalization. It was decided that just Steph Bata, Deputy Tax Director, would attend. Tom Borgen discussed his farm exemption with the commissioners. Traffic counters were discussed and Stanley Dick suggested that the roadmen be trained to help Terry Johnston with them.

Terry Johnston, Road Supervisor, met with the commissioners and reviewed the upcoming road projects, as well as future road projects. Johnston informed the commissioners that he is working with the software company for the traffic counters. Stanley Dick asked Johnston about the damage around Munich from the recent storms, and whether or not there was a chance they would get FEMA. Johnston stated it was not a large enough area to qualify.

The Tax Director position was discussed. The commissioners decided to advertise the position. The job description for the position was reviewed and updated. It was decided to eliminate the separate line for clerk pay from the Tax Director budget. The commissioners were in agreement for Stephanie Bata, Deputy Tax Director, to begin taking certification classes.

David Zeis made a motion to approve the Beer and Liquor License for the Pembina Gorge Foundation, dba Frost Fire, seconded by Richard Ring, motion carried.

Elsie Magnus made a motion to approve the Gaming Site Authorization (Raffle & Poker) for the Langdon Country Club, seconded by Nick Moser, motion carried.

The commissioners asked Lisa Gellner, Auditor, to check with Tanya Wieler to see if she would consider contracting HR for the county.

Mark Ratzlaff met with the commissioners regarding his letter he received for omitted tax on Parcel #26162000. Ratzlaff stated he felt the value was too high. Elsie Magnus made a motion, seconded by David Zeis, to lower the structure value on Parcel #26162000 to \$120,000, motion carried.

Tom Borgen met with the commissioners regarding the omitted tax on being put on Parcel #35224000. Borgen was in agreement with the value that was being put on the parcel.

At 11:50 a.m., Elsie Magnus made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Nick Moser; motion carried.
