***April 25, 2024***

Cavalier County Water Resource Board held a regular meeting on April 25, 2024, at 8:30 a.m. in the Commissioners Room in the Cavalier County Courthouse. Chairman Bob Blake called the meeting to order with Brian Hardy, and Bruce Roder, Charles Damschen, and Secretary Kensi Breyer.

Guests: Taylor Benneweis, Tom Hardy, and Nathan Blair

Bob Blake called the meeting to order.

**Kensi Breyer stated that we need to add the City of Langdon project to the agenda. Bruce Roder made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition, a second was made by Brian Hardy, motion carried.**

**Bruce Roder made a motion to approve the April 11, 2024, regular meeting minutes, second was made by Brian Hardy motion was carried.**

### **New Business:**

City of Langdon Cleanout project, documentation submitted by Moore Engineering. Bob Reviewed the project. The water will flow into the highway ditch. Kensi Breyer stated that Moore Engineering is needing to acknowledge as received for the one that is just a ditch cleaning to original grade because the flows may be higher that it has been in recent years but is just returning to original design. The ones that are not just cleaning to original design need their signature as approved. Brian Hardy made a motion to sign the documents for Moore Engineering as received and approved in the noted areas, a second was made by Bruce Roder, motion carried.

Bruce Roder stated that in Rosa Lake there are culverts that will need to be replaced this fall and a cleanout. This is on the north side of the highway.

Bob stated the ordered culverts by Terry Jacobson's. Mikkelsens have not been able to put the culverts in as the road was still frozen. Bob will have the boards taken out of Schneider's Bridge.

Kensi Breyer stated that she talked to Dan Fischer regarding the permit for Dresden Drain 2. Dan is looking into the permit that is potentially needed for the Corp of Engineers. We will need to have a permit for the pumping of Schiestels. This will be the same format that was done throughout the Cypress 3 drain.

**Old Business:**

Tom Hardy joined the meeting to discuss some items within the Rec Area. Tom addressed the board with a few different concerns he had.

Nathan Blair joined the meeting and submitted a building permit for a dog kennel attached to his deck at the Rec Area. He also addressed the board regarding the new rule on the number of dogs and his five dogs that he has. After discussion, Nathan stated that he will be submitting documentation stating that his dogs are registered emotion support animals. Kensi will be reaching out to Quentin to ask him to review the difference between a service animal and a support animal and any legal standing that we might have. Bruce Roder made a motion to deny the permit for the dog kennel submitted by Nathan Blair, a second was made by Brian Hardy, motion carried.
