

Cavalier County Commission Proceedings

On September 16, 2025, at 8:30 a.m. the Board of Commissioners of Cavalier County, North Dakota, met at the Cavalier County Courthouse in regular session, with all members present. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman Nick Moser called the meeting to order and proceeded as follows:

Moser asked if there were any changes to the agenda. Greg Goodman made a motion to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Stanley Dick; motion carried. Austin Lafrenz made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Shane Gallagher; motion carried.

Terry Johnston, Road Supervisor; and Sheldon Romfo, Road Foreman; and Jeff Daley, KLJ; met with the commissioners to review current road projects. Daley reviewed options for the Flexible Road Funding application with the commissioners.

Jill Denault and Holly Fetsch, NVHSZ, met with the commissioners for a department update. There was discussion on water leaking into the building from the eve troughs. The commissioners asked Josh Plummer, Maintenance, to get an estimate to fix the eve troughs.

At 10:00 a.m. Stanley Dick made a motion to recess the commission meeting for the 2026 budget hearing, seconded by Shane Gallagher, motion carried. At 10:15 a.m. Austin Lafrenz made a motion to re-convene the meeting, seconded by Greg Goodman, motion carried. There was only one taxpayer in attendance for the budget hearing, asking for clarification why she received notice of the budget hearing. **Shane Gallagher made a motion to approve the 2026 budget with no changes from the preliminary budget approval, seconded by Greg Goodman, motion carried.**

A letter from the Bureau of Land Management regarding the resource management plan was reviewed by the commission. **Austin Lafrenz made a motion to choose option 2, requesting not to become a cooperator, but request to be on the mailing list to received notification of public meetings, seconded by Greg Goodman, motion carried.**

Craig Schommer, Mayor for Munich City, met with the commissioners requesting a letter of support to reinstate the Renaissance Zone for Munich City. **Stanley Dick made a motion to approve the proposed letter of support, seconded by Greg Goodman, motion carried.**

Shane Gallagher made a motion to transfer \$1,232.00 from Road & Bridge Fund to Road & Bridge Equipment Replacement Fund, seconded by Austin Lafrenz, motion carried.
