Cavalier County Water Resource Board held a regular session meeting on May 28, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. in the County Commission Meeting Room in the County Courthouse. Chairman Brian Hardy called the meeting to order at 8:31 AM. Bruce Roder, Craig Borgen, Shauna Schneider & Secretary Karen Kempert present.
