June 25, 2026

Cavalier County Water Resource Board held a regular session meeting on June 25, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. in the County Commission Meeting Room in the County Courthouse. Chairman Brian Hardy called the meeting to order at 8:30 AM. Bruce Roder, Craig Borgen, Shauna Schneider, Ordale Morstad & Secretary Karen Kempert present.

Shauna Schneider made a motion to approve the agenda with additions of Dumpster donation and Steve Ratzlaff.

2nd by Craig Borgen – passed unanimously.

Motion was made by Shauna Schneider and 2nd by Ordale Morstad to approve June 4th minutes with grammatical corrections. Motion approved unanimously.

Under old business- No movement on getting the designation of Mt Carmel Dam from Medium Hazard to Low Hazard since it is no longer a source of drinking water.

Dresden 2 update- Brian Hardy talked to Rick Kartes. Rick will speak with Travis Peterson about pumping west with 3 pumps, or 36” culvert always left open through his (Rick’s) land with a trap. This will have to be revoted, Rick said he will think on it. In the meantime, Dan will give us updated engineering costs so that we can send it to Sean Fredericks to see if we are over budget by the 20% that requires a revote on the drain.

New Business-

Steve Ames met with the board about Huron township Texas crossing in the SW corner on section 31. He would like 2 48” culverts upstream and 36” culverts downstream. Board referred to Dan Fischer for his expertise.

Briese lot 112, asked if we could amend payment to just 3 months of camping, so lot rent for 2026 season is \$850.00. Briese’s will drop it off at the courthouse. Board approved

Dock discussion for making one totally ADA compliant. Move the fishing pier north side of beach and talk to ND G& F about concrete for sidewalk and ramp to pier.

Terry Johnston stopped in to discuss repairs at the intersection of county roads 12 & 13 on East Snowflake drain. 4 – 6’ culverts in and 3 for sure are bad, Terry felt one was newer and could be reclaimed. The board added this to Dan Fischer’s list for his input.

9:00 - Mark Romfo entered the meeting to discuss culverts north of Hannah at 165-62-33 there is a hole in the road and he feels it is in West Snowflake. The board questioned whether it is a legal drain to Canada or if it ends in section 8. Dan Fischer was invited to come to the meeting for his input. Dan questioned and recommended that we check and see if this part of the drain is in the Rush Lake files. Shauna and Karen will try to locate the legals for Rush Lake and check into it. The board will give Mark a reclaimed culvert and he will install it in the meantime.

Cameron Sillers requested that the board to do something on his land in Cypress and Dan Fischer stated that it is possibly silted in in the low area. The waterboard should clean it out. The Waterboard spoke to Dan Fischer and the board will contact a contractor to do this.

2027 Budget was presented for discussion. Shauna Schneider will present it along with Karen at the Commissioners meeting set for July 7 at 9:50. Karen amended the budget and with the boards approval it is good to present to commissioners.

Shauna Schneider made a motion to approve the vouchers, 2nd by Ordale Morstad, motion passed unanimously.

Shauna Schneider motioned to adjourn the meeting at 11:20, 2nd by Craig Borgen, motion carried.
